#### ANIMAL

1. In any Order made under the Diseases of Animals Acts (Northern Ireland) 1894 to 1955 in relation to the import, export or movement by sea or inland waters of animals (including poultry) animal carcases, hay and straw, and in force at the commencement of this Order, references to:—

- i transport by sea and by water shall be construed as including references to transport by air;
- ii shipment in or landing or disembarking from vessels shall be construed as including references to shipment in or landing or disembarking from aircraft:
- iii vessels shall be construed as including references to aircraft;
- iv a port shall be construed as including references to an aerodrome;
- v a master of a vessel shall be construed as including reference to a pilot or other person having the command or charge of an aircraft;

and every such Order shall have effect accordingly.

### Citation and Commencement

2. This Order may be cited as the Transport by Air Order (Northern Ireland) 1955 and shall come into operation on the first day of August, 1955.
