The Ministry of Home Affairs, in exercise of the powers vested in it by Section 8 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland), 1929, and of all powers thereunto enabling it, hereby makes the following Regulations, that is to say:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Vehicles (Carrickfergus, County Antrim) Regulations, 1955.

2. A person shall not, except by the express direction or permission of a member of the Royal Ulster Constabulary, drive or propel a vehicle of any kind whatsoever in any street or length of street in the Borough of Carrickfergus in the County of Antrim specified in the Schedule to these Regulations except in the direction prescribed in relation to that street in the Schedule.

Registration and Licensing

REGULATIONS, DATED 16TH AUGUST, 1955, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE UNDER THE VEHICLES (EXCISE) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1954.

The Ministry of Commerce for Northern Ireland in exercise of the powers conferred upon it under or by virtue of The Vehicles (Excise) Act (Northern Ireland), 1954(a), and every other power thereunto enabling it hereby makes the following Regulations:—

(a) 1954 C. 17 (N.I.).

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as “The Road Vehicles (Registration and Licensing) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1955”.

(2) The Road Vehicles (Registration and Licensing) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1954(a), are hereby revoked.

(3) In these Regulations:—

The expression “Principal Regulations” means “The Road Vehicles (Registration and Licensing) (Northern Ireland) Regulations, 1947” (b), which make provision, amongst other things, for the registration of mechanically-propelled vehicles and for the allotting to each of the Councils mentioned in the first column of the Fourth Schedule thereto, of the Index Mark or Index Marks shown opposite to the name of that Council in the second column of the said Schedule.

2. The Principal Regulations shall have effect as though the Schedule to these Regulations were substituted for the Fourth Schedule thereto.
