The Minister of Agriculture by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the Agriculture (Temporary Assistance) Act (Northern Ireland), 1954, and of all other powers him thereunto enabling, and with the approval of the Minister of Finance hereby makes the following Scheme:—

1.—(1) This Scheme may be cited as the Acreage Payments (Potatoes) (Amendment) Scheme (Northern Ireland), 1955, and shall be construed as one with the Acreage Payments (Potatoes) Scheme (Northern Ireland), 1955.

(2) This Scheme shall come into operation on 5th September, 1955.

2. The Acreage Payments (Potatoes) Scheme (Northern Ireland), 1955, shall have effect as if—

### AGRICULTURAL SCHEMES

- (a) in Article 6 thereof, which specifies the date by which application for acreage payments shall be made to the Ministry, for the words "the 16th day of July, 1955," there were substituted the words "the 17th day of September, 1955;" and
- (b) at the end of Part II of the Schedule, which names the varieties of potatoes in respect of which acreage payments may not be made, the names of the following varieties were added:—

"Ulster Emblem"

"Ulster Premier"

# Agricultural Development (Eradication of Rushes on Marginal Land) Extension Scheme, 1955

SCHEME DATED 14TH FEBRUARY, 1955, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION 6 OF THE AGRICULTURE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1949(a).

The Ministry of Agriculture, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sub-section (1) of Section 6 of the Agriculture Act (Northern Ireland), 1949, and with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following Scheme:—

1. This Scheme, which may be cited as the Agricultural Development (Eradication of Rushes on Marginal Land) Extension Scheme, 1955, shall come into operation on 1st day of March, 1955.

2. The Agricultural Development (Eradication of Rushes on Marginal Land) Scheme(b) is hereby varied as follows:—

In paragraph 2, which prescribes the date of termination of the Scheme, the words "29th February, 1956" shall be substituted for the words "28th February, 1955".
