Primary Schools: Salaries and Allowances

REGULATIONS DATED 21ST SEPTEMBER, 1955, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION UNDER THE EDUCATION ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1947 TO 1953, AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE.

The Ministry of Education (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Sections 83 and 112 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland), 1947, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and after consultation with the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Primary Schools (Salaries and Allowances) Amending Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1955.

(2) These Regulations shall come into operation on the 1st day of October, 1955.

(3) In these Regulations the expression "the principal Regulations" means the Primary Schools (Salaries and Allowances) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1954(a);

"the relevant proportion" has the meaning assigned to it by Regulation 4.

(4) These Regulations amend and shall be construed as one with the principal Regulations.

2.—(1) The sum shown opposite to each year of service of each of the scales for women teachers specified in Regulation 4 of the principal Regulations shall be augmented by the addition of the relevant proportion of the difference between the aforesaid sum and the sum shown opposite to the same year of service of the corresponding scale for men.

(2) Each of the allowances specified for women teachers in sub-paragraphs (a), (b) and (c) of paragraph (2) of Regulation 11 of the principal Regulations shall be augmented by the addition of the relevant proportion of the difference between the allowance applicable to a man and the allowance applicable to a woman under the appropriate sub-paragraph of the said Regulation 11.

3.—(1) From 1st April, 1961, the salary scale for full-time unqualified women teachers who were first appointed as unqualified teachers (other than as locum tenens or substitute teachers) in primary schools in Northern Ireland prior to 1st January, 1947, shall be as follows:—

(2) From 1st April, 1961, the following yearly rates of salary shall be paid to full-time unqualified women teachers who were first appointed in primary schools in Northern Ireland on or after 1st January, 1947, provided that they hold the Ministry's Grammar School Senior Certificate or have attained an equivalent or higher standard of education:—

(3) From 1st April, 1961, the following yearly rates of salary shall be paid to full-time unqualified women teachers (other than those specified in paragraph (2) of this Regulation) who were first appointed in primary schools in Northern Ireland on or after 1st January, 1947:—

If total service is not less than two years and	
(a) the teacher is under 21 years of age	245
(b) the teacher has reached 21 years of age	260

(4) The sum shown opposite to each year of service of the scale set out in paragraph (1) of Regulation 5 of the principal Regulations shall be augmented by the addition of the relevant proportion of the difference between that sum and the sum shown opposite to the same year of service of the scale set out in paragraph (1) of this Regulation.

(5) Each of the rates of salary set out in paragraph (2) of Regulation 5 of the principal Regulations shall be augmented by the addition of the relevant proportion of the difference between that rate and the corresponding rate set out in paragraph (2) of this Regulation.

(6) Each of the rates of salary for women teachers set out in paragraph (3) of Regulation 5 of the principal Regulations shall be augmented by the addition of the relevant proportion of the difference between that rate and the corresponding rate set out in paragraph (3) of this Regulation.

4. The relevant proportion for each period set out in column (i) below shall be the proportion specified opposite in column (ii).

From 1st October, 1955 to 31st March, 1956	one seventh
„ 1st April, 1956 „ 31st March, 1957	two sevenths
„ 1st April, 1957 „ 31st March, 1958	three sevenths
„ 1st April, 1958 „ 31st March, 1959	four sevenths
„ 1st April, 1959 „ 31st March, 1960	five sevenths
„ 1st April, 1960 „ 31st March, 1961	six sevenths

Provided that where the amount of the addition includes a fraction of a pound the said fraction shall be ignored if it is under ten shillings and reckoned as one pound if it is ten shillings or over.

5. From 1st April, 1961, the salaries and allowances prescribed for full-time qualified men teachers shall apply equally to full-time qualified women teachers.

6. Paragraph (3) of Regulation 11 of the principal Regulations shall have effect as if for the words “ and in the case of a man a further annual increment of £25, to the maximum of Scale V ” wheresoever they occur there were substituted “ and a final annual increment to the maximum of Scale V ”.
