- 11. The scales of salary prescribed in these Regulations shall remain in force until such time as they are varied by Regulations made by the Ministry after consultation with the Ministry of Finance.
- 12. The salaries of the Principals of the training colleges shall be determined by the Ministry, subject to the approval of the Ministry of Finance.
- 13.—If any question arises as to the interpretation of these Regulations, or as to whether any of the requirements thereof are fulfilled, or as to the amount of any payment thereunder, the decision of the Ministry shall be final.
- 14. The Training College Teachers' (Salaries and Allowances) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1951, as amended by the Training College Teachers' (Salaries and Allowances) Amending Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1954, are hereby revoked.

REGULATIONS DATED 21ST SEPTEMBER, 1955, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION UNDER THE EDUCATION ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1947 TO 1953, AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE.

The Ministry of Education in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Sections 83 and 112 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland), 1947, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf and after consultation with the Ministry of Finance hereby makes the following Regulations:—

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the "Training College Teachers (Salaries and Allowances) Amending Regulations, 1955".
- (2) These Regulations shall take effect as from 1st October, 1955.
- (3) In these Regulations "the principal Regulations" means the Training College Teachers (Salaries and Allowances) Regulations, 1955(a), and "the relevant proportion" has the meaning assigned to it by Regulation 3.
- (4) These Regulations shall apply to the salaries of women who are employed as lecturers or as senior lecturers in training colleges.

- 2. In the case of any person to whom these Regulations apply, the salary, calculated under the provisions of the principal Regulations, shall be augmented by the addition of the relevant proportion of the difference between the aforesaid sum and the amount of salary which would be payable to that person if the provisions relating to the salaries of men in those Regulations were applicable to both men and women.
- 3. The relevant proportion for service given during the periods set out in column (i) below shall be the proportion shown opposite in column (ii).

Provided that where the amount of the addition includes a fraction of a pound the said fraction shall be ignored if under 10s. and reckoned as £1 0s. 0d. if it is 10s. or over.

4. From the 1st April, 1961, the salaries prescribed for men shall apply equally to women.
