## BACON INDUSTRY Bacon Publicity Grant

ORDER, DATED ELEVENTH OCTOBER, 1955, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SUB-SECTION (1) OF SECTION FOURTEEN OF THE AGRICULTURAL MARKETING ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1933, AS AMENDED BY SUB-SECTION (3) OF SECTION 2 OF THE MARKETING OF PIGS (AMENDMENT) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1954.

Whereas the Pigs Marketing Board (Northern Ireland) (hereinafter referred to as "the Board") are the Board administering the Pigs Marketing Scheme (Northern Ireland), 1933, duly framed and approved under the Agricultural Marketing Act (Northern Ireland), 1933, (hereinafter referred to as "the Scheme"):

AND WHEREAS, in pursuance of sub-section (3) of Section 2 of the Marketing of Pigs (Amendment) Act (Northern Ireland), 1954, paragraph 34 of the Scheme provides that any moneys standing to the credit of the fund which are not required for the operation of the Scheme or otherwise for the purposes of the Pigs and Bacon Marketing Acts shall be applied for the benefit of the pig-producing industry in such manner as the Ministry of Agriculture (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") may from time to time by order direct:

AND WHEREAS, by Section 14(1) of the Agricultural Marketing Act (Northern Ireland), 1933, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") it is provided that the Ministry may by regulations make such provision as appears to the Ministry to be necessary for giving full effect to this Act:

Now, THEREFORE, the Ministry, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by the Act and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order, that is to say:—

- 1. The Board shall pay the sum of £5,000 on or before 31st October, 1955, the sum of £2,500 on or before 31st January, 1956, and the sum of £2,500 on or before 30th April, 1956, to the Bacon Information Council Limited, Empire House, St. Martins-le-Grand, London.
- 2. This Order may be cited as the Bacon Industry (Bacon Publicity Grant) Order (Northern Ireland), 1955, and shall come into operation on the date hereof.
