ORDER, DATED 24TH MARCH, 1955, MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SUB-SECTION (6) OF SECTION TWENTY-SIX OF THE ADMINISTRATION OF JUSTICE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1954.

I, THE RIGHT HONOURABLE GEORGE BOYLE HANNA, Q.C., Minister of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, in pursuance of sub-section (6) of section twenty-six of the Administration of Justice Act (Northern Ireland), 1954, do hereby order as follows:—

1. As from the 1st day of April, 1955, it shall be illegal for any Crier at Sessions to demand or receive from any person any fee or gratuity other than fees payable to him in any other official capacity under or by virtue of any enactment.

2. This Order may be cited as the Administration of Justice (Criers at Sessions) Order (Northern Ireland), 1955.
