

(6) Each of the rates of salary for women teachers set out in paragraph (3) of Regulation 5 of the principal Regulations shall be augmented by the addition of the relevant proportion of the difference between that rate and the corresponding rate set out in paragraph (3) of this Regulation.

4. The relevant proportion for each period set out in column (i) below shall be the proportion specified opposite in column (ii).

(i) Period	(ii) Proportion
From 1st October, 1955 to 31st March, 1956	one seventh
„ 1st April, 1956 „ 31st March, 1957	two sevenths
„ 1st April, 1957 „ 31st March, 1958	three sevenths
„ 1st April, 1958 „ 31st March, 1959	four sevenths
„ 1st April, 1959 „ 31st March, 1960	five sevenths
„ 1st April, 1960 „ 31st March, 1961	six sevenths

Provided that where the amount of the addition includes a fraction of a pound the said fraction shall be ignored if it is under ten shillings and reckoned as one pound if it is ten shillings or over.

5. From 1st April, 1961, the salaries and allowances prescribed for full-time qualified men teachers shall apply equally to full-time qualified women teachers.

6. Paragraph (3) of Regulation 11 of the principal Regulations shall have effect as if for the words “ and in the case of a man a further annual increment of £25, to the maximum of Scale V ” wheresoever they occur there were substituted “ and a final annual increment to the maximum of Scale V ”.

REGULATIONS DATED 25TH APRIL, 1955, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF  
EDUCATION UNDER THE EDUCATION ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1947.

The Ministry of Education in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Section 112 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland), 1947, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations;—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Technical School Examinations (Amendment) (No. 5) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1955.

(2) In these Regulations the expression “the principal Regulations” means the Technical School Examinations Regulations, 1933, as amended by subsequent Regulations other than these Regulations.

(3) These Regulations shall be construed as one with the principal Regulations.

2. The principal Regulations shall have effect as if for Regulation 15 thereof there were substituted the following Regulation:—

“15. Candidates will be notified of the result obtained by them in each subject of the examination.”

3. These Regulations shall come into operation on the date hereof.
