The Ministry of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland in exercise of the powers vested in it by Section 6 of the Motor Vehicles (Traffic and Regulation) Act (Northern Ireland), 1926(a), and section 4 of the Roads Act (Northern Ireland), 1948(b), and of every other power enabling it, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Vehicles (County Armagh Speed Limit) Regulations, 1955.
- No person driving or in charge of a motor car when in use on that part of the Belfast-Ballygawley-Londonderry Trunk Road in the administrative County of Armagh between the cross roads known as the Birches Cross Roads in the townland of Ballinary and Verner's Bridge in the townland of Mullinakill shall cause or suffer it to proceed at a greater speed than Twenty-five miles an hour.
