

that the rates of such fees to be paid to the Ministry for each carcase (including offals) examined shall be as follows:—

Beef	Two shillings and sixpence
Pork	Eightpence
Mutton or Lamb	Fourpence
Goat	Fourpence
Horse	Two shillings and sixpence

(b) Such fees shall be payable on demand to the Ministry.

2. This Order may be cited as the Meat Examination Fees Order (Northern Ireland), 1956, and shall come into operation on the 7th day of May, 1956.

The Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in it under the Diseases of Animals Acts (Northern Ireland), 1894 to 1955,(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

Short Title

1. This Order may be cited as the Importation of Swine from the Irish Republic Order (Northern Ireland) 1956.

Prohibition of Importation

2. The importation into Northern Ireland of any species of swine from the Irish Republic is prohibited except under and in accordance with the conditions of a licence granted by the Ministry.

Offences

3. Any person committing or aiding, abetting, counselling or procuring the commission of any breach of the provisions of this Order is liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided by the Diseases of Animals Acts 1894 to 1955.

Commencement

4. This Order shall come into operation on the 18th August, 1956.

The Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in it under the Diseases of Animals Acts (Northern Ireland) 1894 to 1955,(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation, Commencement and Construction

1. This Order, which may be cited as the Importation of Swine from Irish Republic (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1956, shall come into operation on the seventeenth day of October, 1956, and shall be read as one with the Importation of Swine from Irish Republic Order (Northern Ireland) 1956(b) (hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Order").
