Now THEREFORE after considering observations sent to it in regard to the Scheme, and having held an Inquiry in pursuance of section 3 of the Act, the Ministry by virtue of the provisions of section 3 of the Act doth hereby confirm the Scheme without modification.

The Ministry of Education (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Sections 104

and 112 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland), 1947, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

- 1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Educational Services (Imperial Institute) Grants Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1956.
- (2) These Regulations shall come into operation on the date hereof.
- 2. In accordance with arrangements approved by the Ministry of Finance, and subject to the requirements of these Regulations, the Ministry may make grants to the Imperial Institute, South Kensington, London, (hereinafter referred to as "the Institute") in respect of expenditure incurred by the Institute on educational services provided for Northern Ireland.
- 3. Any arrangements made by the Institute for lecture tours, conferences or other educational services shall be subject to the approval of the Ministry.
- 4. Before approving any arrangements under the foregoing Regulation, the Ministry shall consult the Association of Northern Ireland Education Committees and such other bodies as it considers appropriate, having regard to the nature of the arrangements.
