

(2) For paragraph (ii) of Regulation 4 there shall be substituted the following:—

- (ii) the sum of one shilling in respect of each quantity of a drug and each appliance or component part thereof supplied to him, other than a scheduled appliance.

Provided that the supply of quantities of the same drug in more than one container, or the supply of more than one appliance of the same type, or two or more component parts of the same appliance, shall be deemed to be the supply of one quantity of a drug only, or one appliance, as the case may be.

(3) Regulation 6 is hereby revoked.

### Hospital Charges for Drugs and Appliances

REGULATIONS\* DATED 19TH DECEMBER, 1956, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER THE HEALTH SERVICES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1948.

The Ministry of Health and Local Government, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by paragraph eighteen of Part II of the First Schedule to the Public Health (Tuberculosis) Act (Northern Ireland), 1946, and by Section 76 of the Health Services Act (Northern Ireland), 1948, and of all other powers

enabling it in that behalf, and with the approval of the Ministry of Finance hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Health Services (Hospital Charges for Drugs and Appliances, etc.) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1956, and shall come into operation on the first day of January, 1957.

2. The Health Services (Hospital Charges for Drugs and Appliances, etc.) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1952(a) shall be amended as follows:—

(1) For sub-paragraph (i) of paragraph 1 of Regulation 2 there shall be substituted the following sub-paragraph:—

“(i) the sum of one shilling in respect of each quantity of a drug supplied on any one occasion.

Provided that the supply of quantities of the same drug in more than one container shall be deemed to be the supply of one quantity of a drug only; and ”

(2) Paragraph 2 of the said Regulation 2 is hereby revoked.

(3) For paragraph (ii) of Regulation 3 there shall be substituted the following paragraph:—

“(ii) the sum of one shilling in respect of each quantity of a drug and each appliance or component part thereof, other than a listed appliance, supplied to him by virtue of an order on a prescription form or other form of order.

Provided that an order on the same form for quantities of the same drug to be supplied in more than one container, or for more than one appliance, of the same type, or for the supply of two or more component parts of the same appliance, shall be deemed to be an order for one quantity of a drug only, or for one appliance, as the case may be.”
