2. The principal Scheme, in its relation to Blackface Rams of the Mourne type shall be modified as follows:—

- (a) Rams must be for location in such districts in County Down as may be approved by the Ministry.
- (b) The grant in respect of any one such animal shall not exceed £4.

The Ministry of Agriculture, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sub-section (1) of Section 6 of the Agriculture Act (Northern Ireland), 1949, and with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following Scheme:—

1. This Scheme, which may be cited as the Agricultural Development (Eradication of Rushes on Marginal Land) Extension Scheme, 1956, shall come into operation on 1st day of March, 1956.

2. The Agricultural Development (Eradication of Rushes on Marginal Land) Scheme(b) as amended by the Agricultural Development (Eradication of Rushes on Marginal Land) Extension Scheme 1955(c) is hereby varied as follows:—

In paragraph 2, which prescribes the date of termination of the Scheme, the words "28th February, 1957" shall be substituted for the words "29th February, 1956".

Agricultural Development (Fertiliser) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1956.

AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION 6 OF THE AGRICULTURE ACT
(NORTHERN IRELAND), 1949(a).

The Ministry of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sub-section (1) of Section 6 of the Agriculture Act (Northern Ireland), 1949, and of every other power enabling it in that behalf and with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following scheme:—

1. This scheme may be cited as the Agricultural Development (Fertiliser) Scheme (Northern Ireland), 1956.

2. In this scheme, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:—

“the Act” means the Agriculture Act (Northern Ireland), 1949;

“agricultural land” means any land in Northern Ireland used as arable meadow or pasture ground, or for the purpose of poultry farming, market gardens, nursery grounds, orchards or allotments;

“arable land” means land in Northern Ireland which is cultivated or which in the opinion of the Ministry is capable of being cultivated;

“occupier” means the person who, by virtue of an agreement, whether written or otherwise, has the right to the use of the land and who is responsible for its management and includes an association of farmers, allotment holders or small holders or other similar association which acquires fertilisers in bulk for redistribution to its members;
