- 1. These Rules may be cited as the Local Government (Superannuation) County Court Rules, 1956. In these Rules the expression "the Regulations" means the Local Government (Superannuation) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1950.
- 2.—(1) A notice of application for the determination of any question under Regulation 36 of the Regulations may be in the Form No. 1 in the First Schedule.
- (2) Notice of the application shall, not later than ten days before the sitting of the Court by which the application is to be heard, be served either personally or by registered post on every body or person with whom the question to be determined has arisen, who shall be the respondent or respondents.
- 3.—(1) Where not otherwise expressly provided by these Rules, the existing Rules and practice of the County Court in Equity cases shall apply to all applications under the Regulations.
- (2) The Court may direct that notice of any such application be served on any body or person not served therewith and for that purpose may adjourn the hearing on such terms as to costs and otherwise as the Court may think just.
- 4. The Court may make such order as to costs and witnesses' expenses as it may think just.
- 5. An order determining a question under the Regulations may be in Form No. 2 in the First Schedule.
- 6. There shall be payable in respect of every application under these Rules the Court fees specified in the Second Schedule which shall be paid by County Court Stamps.
