

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to convey their general purport)*

Regulation 4 provides for the determination of the maximum number and aggregate value of posts of special responsibility in the case of a newly-recognised school.

REGULATIONS, DATED 28TH JUNE, 1957, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION UNDER THE EDUCATION ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1947 TO 1956, AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE.

The Ministry of Education (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Sections 83 and 112 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland), 1947, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and after consultation with the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Intermediate School (Salaries and Allowances of Teachers) Amending Regulations No. 2, 1957.

2. Save as provided in Regulation 4, these Regulations shall come into operation on the date hereof.

3. The existing Regulations hereby amended are the Intermediate School (Salaries and Allowances of Teachers) Regulations, 1957(a).

4.—(1) For paragraph (1) of Regulation 10 of the existing Regulations there shall be substituted the following:—

"The rate of remuneration of a person employed in a full-time capacity during the absence of a teacher or as a temporary teacher shall be on a daily basis at the rate of 1/200th of the annual rate of salary which he would receive if he were employed in a permanent capacity: Provided that such a person may, with the approval of the Ministry, be paid salary as though he were employed in a permanent capacity. For the purposes of this Regulation not more than five working days shall be counted in any one week."

(2) This Regulation shall come into operation on the 1st day of August, 1957.

5. For the date "31st July, 1957" in paragraph (1) of Regulation 14 of the existing Regulations there shall be substituted the date "31st October, 1957".
