

Blackface (Mourne) Rams Scheme, 1957.

SCHEME DATED 28TH JUNE, 1957, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION 9 OF THE AGRICULTURE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1949(a).

The Ministry of Agriculture by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section nine of the Agriculture Act (Northern Ireland), 1949, and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, and with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following Scheme to modify the Blackface Rams Scheme, 1954(b) (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Scheme"):

Citation and Commencement

1. This Scheme may be cited as the Blackface (Mourne) Rams Scheme, 1957, and shall come into operation on the first day of August, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven.

Revocation

2. The Blackface (Mourne) Rams Scheme, 1956, is hereby revoked.

Modification of the principal Scheme

3. The principal Scheme, in its relation to Blackface rams of the Mourne type shall be modified as follows:—

- (a) Rams must be for location in such districts in counties Armagh and Down as may be approved by the Ministry.
- (b) The grant in respect of any one such animal shall not exceed £4.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Scheme incorporates the provisions of the Blackface (Mourne) Rams Scheme, 1956, but provides for the payment of grants in respect of Mourne type rams for location in approved districts in County Armagh as well as in County Down:
