duties or produces satisfactory medical evidence that she is unable to resume duty owing to illness and that her absence is not due to childbirth.

(6) This Regulation shall apply to absences which commence after 31st March, 1958: Provided that in respect of any absence which commenced on or before that date the provisions of Regulation 34 of the existing Regulations shall apply as if this Regulation had not been made."
