I, the Right Honourable W. W. B. Topping, Q.C., Minister of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section thirty-six of the Betting and Lotteries Act (Northern Ireland), 1957, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, do hereby Order as follows:—

1. The provisions of the said Act specified in the first column of the Schedule hereto (which relate to matters specified in the second column of the said Schedule) shall come into operation on the first day of August, 1957.

2. This Order may be cited as the Betting and Lotteries Act (Northern Ireland), 1957 (Date of Commencement) Order, 1957.
