REGULATIONS, DATED 7TH NOVEMBER, 1957, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION UNDER THE EDUCATION ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1947 TO 1956, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE.

The Ministry of Education (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Sections 104 and 112 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland), 1947, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Educational Services (Council for Education in World Citizenship) Grant Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1957.

(2) These Regulations shall come into operation on 1st April, 1958.

2. In accordance with arrangements approved by the Ministry of Finance and subject to the requirements of these Regulations the Ministry may make grants to the Council for Education in World Citizenship (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in respect of expenditure incurred by the Council on services provided for Northern Ireland with the approval of the Ministry.

3. The Council shall furnish to the Ministry each year a statement of accounts for the preceding financial year duly certified by a qualified accountant and such other information relating to the Council's work in Northern Ireland as the Ministry may from time to time require.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport).

These Regulations provide for the payment by the Ministry of Education to the Council for Education in World Citizenship of grants in respect of expenditure incurred by the Council on services provided in Northern Ireland.
