

**Factories (Employment of Women in Bakehouses)**

THE BAKEHOUSES (SUNDAY BEFORE CHRISTMAS) (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER, 1957, DATED 13TH DECEMBER, 1957, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR AND NATIONAL INSURANCE FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER REGULATION 59 OF THE DEFENCE (GENERAL) REGULATIONS, 1939, AS HAVING EFFECT BY VIRTUE OF THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS) ACT, 1945(a) (AS EXTENDED BY THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (EXTENDED PURPOSES) ACT, 1947(b) AND THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (DEFENCE PURPOSES) ACT, 1951(c) AND CONTINUED IN FORCE BY THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (CONTINUANCE) ORDER, 1957(d)).

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Regulation 59 of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, as having effect by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) Act, 1945(a) (as extended by the Supplies and Services (Extended Purposes) Act, 1947(b) and the Supplies and Services (Defence Purposes) Act, 1951(c) and continued in force by the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1957(d)) and of all other powers thereunto it enabling, the Ministry of Labour and National Insurance for Northern Ireland hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Bakehouses (Sunday before Christmas) (Northern Ireland) Order, 1957, and shall come into operation on the 22nd day of December, 1957.

2. This Order applies to all factories in which the manufacture of bread or flour confectionery other than biscuits is carried on.

3. Factories to which this Order applies are hereby exempted in respect of Sunday, the 22nd day of December, 1957, from the provisions of Section 83 of the Factories Act (Northern Ireland), 1938(e) (which relates to the prohibition of Sunday employment) as respects the employment of women in the manufacture of bread or flour confectionery other than biscuits or in work incidental or ancillary to such manufacture.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)*

This Order exempts bakehouses in Northern Ireland from the prohibition of the employment of women on Sunday contained in Section 83 of the Factories Act (Northern Ireland), 1938. The exemption is in respect of Sunday, the 22nd day of December, 1957.

BY THE GOVERNOR IN THE PRIVY COUNCIL OF NORTHERN IRELAND.

I, John de Vere, Baron Wakehurst, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor of Northern Ireland, by and with the advice of the Privy Council in Northern Ireland, in pursuance and by virtue of section sixty-one of the Supreme Court of Judicature Act (Ireland), 1877(a), as that enactment applies to the Supreme Court of Judicature of Northern Ireland(b) and of all other powers enabling me in this behalf, upon the recommendation and with the concurrence of a majority of all the Judges of the said Supreme Court of Judicature for the time being (of which majority the Lord Chief Justice of Northern Ireland was one) and the other persons mentioned in the said section sixty-one as applied as aforesaid, do by this Order make the Rules of Court set out in the Schedule hereto (which amend the Rules of the Supreme Court of Northern Ireland(c) in the manner appearing in that Schedule).

This Order may be cited as the Supreme Court Rules (Northern Ireland), Order in Council, 1957, and shall come into force on the first day of July, 1957.
