

5.—(1) The Scientific Research Grants Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1950(a), are hereby revoked:

Provided that any award made under those Regulations may be continued as though it had been made under these Regulations.

(2) Notwithstanding the revocation of the Regulations referred to in the previous paragraph the holder of a Scientific Research Grant awarded thereunder may continue to hold the grant as if the Regulations had not been revoked.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport).*

These Regulations make continued provision for the former Maintenance Allowances which will in future be known as Research Studentships, and, in addition, provide for the award of Advanced Course Studentships in Science and Technology and State Studentships in Arts subjects.

In future Senior Research Grants will be made by the Department of Scientific and Industrial Research, London.

#### Primary Schools (General) (Amending)

REGULATIONS DATED 28TH FEBRUARY, 1957, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION UNDER THE EDUCATION ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1947 TO 1956, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE.

The Ministry of Education in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Sections 104 and 112 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland), 1947, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and with the approval of the Ministry of Finance hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Primary Schools (General) (Amending) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1957.

2. These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st October, 1956.

3.—(1) The existing Regulations hereby amended are the Primary Schools (General) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1949(a), as amended by the Primary Schools (General) (Amending) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1950(b), 1952(c) and 1953(d).

(2) The following Regulations are hereby repealed:—  
the Primary Schools (General) (Amending) Regulations (Northern Ireland) (No. 2), 1953(e); and  
the Primary Schools (General) (Amending) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1954(f).

4. For Regulation 21 of the existing Regulations there shall be substituted the following Regulation:—

“21.—(1) A points score shall be determined for each school on the basis of the enrolment of pupils in the school at 31st December as follows:—

For each pupil under 13 years of age ..... 1 point  
For each pupil aged 13 and under 15 years  
of age ..... 2 points  
For each pupil aged 15 years and over ..... 4 points

(2) Where the points score of a school at 31st December exceeds 200, a vice-principal may be recognised during the school year commencing 1st August following.

(3) Other posts of special responsibility may, on the recommendation of the school authorities, be recognised in accordance with the following table:—

Points score at 31st December	Number of posts which may be recognised during the school year commencing 1st August following
301 to 400	1
401 to 500	2
501 to 600	3
601 to 700	4
701 to 800	5
801 to 900	5
901 to 1,000	6
1,001 to 1,100	7
1,101 to 1,200	8
Exceeding 1,200	9

(4) In the case of a school not recognised in the preceding year ended 31st December, or of a school which has been formed by the amalgamation of two or more grant-aided schools, the points score for the purpose of this Regulation shall be determined by the Ministry.

(5) In a school in which, in addition to the post of vice-principal, one or more posts of special responsibility are recognised, either the post of vice-principal or one of such posts of special responsibility shall normally be held by a woman teacher, and in a school in which the points score exceeds 500, either the post of vice-principal or one of the posts of special responsibility shall normally be held by a woman in charge of the infants' department."

5. Regulations 43, 44, 45, 47, 48 and 49 of, and the First Schedule to, the existing Regulations are hereby repealed.
