

Moneyreagh Road, Moneyreagh, Co. Down, from a point approximately 320 yards north of the junction with the Ballykeel Quarry Road to a point approximately 448 yards south of this junction.

Ballykeel Quarry Road, Moneyreagh, Co. Down, from the junction with the Moneyreagh Road to a point approximately 180 yards west of this junction.

Rockland Drive, Moneyreagh, Co. Down, for its full length.

The Belfast-Holywood, via Knocknagoney Road (Old Holywood Road), Class III No. C.303, Co. Down, from the junction with Jackson's Road, Holywood, to a point approximately 1,955 yards south of this junction.

Richmond Road (Doctor's Road), Co. Down, from the junction with the Belfast-Bangor Road, Trunk Road No. T.1, to the junction with the Belfast-Holywood, via Knocknagoney Road (Old Holywood Road), Class III No. C.303, Co. Down.

The Carrickmore-Pomeroy Road, Class II No. B.4, Pomeroy, Co. Tyrone, from a point approximately 200 yards west of the junction with Fair Hill, Class III No. C.621, to a point approximately 650 yards west of this junction.

THIRD SCHEDULE

Strand Road, Trunk Road No. T.7, Coleraine, Co. Londonderry, from the junction with the Coleraine-Kilrea Road, Class I No. A.54, to a point approximately 70 yards south of the junction with Shuttle Hill.

ROAD VEHICLES

REGULATIONS, DATED 22ND DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1958, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1929.

The Ministry of Home Affairs, in exercise of the powers vested in it by Section 8 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland), 1929, and of all powers thereunto enabling it, hereby makes the following Regulations, that is to say:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Vehicles (Gallows Hill, Dunluce, Co. Antrim) Regulations, 1958.
2. A person shall not, except by the express direction or permission of a member of the Royal Ulster Constabulary, drive or propel a vehicle of any kind whatsoever in the portion of road in County Antrim specified in the schedule to these Regulations except in the direction prescribed in relation to the road in the schedule.

COUNTY OF ANTRIM

<i>Road</i>	<i>Direction</i>
Portrush-Bushmills Road (Route A.2)	(i) At Gallows Hill, Dunluce, traffic on the Northern portion of route shall proceed in a generally Easterly direction
	(ii) at Gallows Hill, Dunluce, traffic on the Southern portion of route shall proceed in a generally Westerly direction.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations give effect to a one-way system of traffic on a short stretch of road where separate routes are available for East and West bound traffic.
