## The Stormont Estate

REGULATIONS, DATED THE 13TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 1958, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER SECTION 1 OF THE STORMONT REGULATION AND GOVERNMENT PROPERTY ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1933.

## 1958. No. 163 [C]

The Ministry of Finance, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section one of the Stormont Regulation and Government Property Act (Northern Ireland), 1933, and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Stormont Estate (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1958, and shall be construed as one with the Stormont Estate Regulations, 1933(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Regulations").

2. The following Regulation shall be inserted after Regulation 3 of the Principal Regulations:—

"3A. Persons or vehicles proceeding to or from the Maynard Sinclair Pavilion or the adjoining playing fields shall be allowed to enter and leave the Estate at reasonable hours by the road leading from the Upper Newtownards Road to the aforesaid Pavilion."

3.—(1) In Regulation 4 of the Principal Regulations, for "Regulations 2 and 3" there shall be substituted "Regulations 2, 3 and 3A".

(2) In paragraph (4) of Regulation 3 of the Stormont Estate (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1951(b) the figure "3A" shall be inserted after the words in brackets.
