ORDER, DATED THE 28TH DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1958, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER SECTION 6(3) OF THE LOUGH NEAGH AND LOWER BANN DRAINAGE AND NAVIGATION ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1955(a).

The Ministry of Finance (hereinafter called "the Ministry") in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sub-section (3) of section six of the Lough Neagh and Lower Bann Drainage and Navigation Act (Northern Ireland), 1955(a), hereby makes the following Order:—

1. The 1st day of January, 1959, is hereby prescribed as the date from which all liabilities, if any, of the Ministry as successor under Part I of the Drainage Act (Northern Ireland), 1929(b), to the Lower Bann Navigation Trustees for any dredging or navigation work shall cease, except and in so far only as the Ministry is liable, as successor to the said Trustees, for the works specified in paragraphs (i), (ii) and (iii) of sub-section (3) of section six of the Lower Bann Drainage and Navigation Act (Northern Ireland), 1955(a).

2. This Order may be cited as the Lower Bann Navigation (Partial Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland), 1958.
