INTOXICATING LIQUOR

Claims Fund: Charges in respect of Licences

- Order, dated 15th July, 1959, made by the Ministry of Finance under section 3 of the Intoxicating Liquor Act (Northern Ireland), 1923(a), as amended by the Intoxicating Liquor (Finance) Act (Northern Ireland), 1925(b), and by section 14 of the Finance Act (Northern Ireland), 1959(c).
- 1. In pursuance of section three of the Intoxicating Liquor Act (Northern Ireland), 1923, as amended by the Intoxicating Liquor (Finance) Act (Northern Ireland), 1925, and by section fourteen of the Finance Act (Northern Ireland), 1959, the Ministry of Finance hereby prescribes that the rates at which Claims Fund Charges are to be levied in respect of all licences for the sale of intoxicating liquor by retail granted or renewed during the year ending the 30th September, 1960, shall be eleven shillings for each pound sterling of the maximum rates of charge authorised by sub-section (3)(b) of section three of the Intoxicating Liquor Act (Northern Ireland), 1923, as amended as aforesaid.
- 2. This Order may be cited as the Intoxicating Liquor (Claims Fund Charges) Order (Northern Ireland), 1959.
