- 5. the heading to paragraphs 9 to 11 were deleted.
- 6. in paragraph 14 the words "on the completion of four years' employment in the trade in the case of a learner whose period of learnership commenced prior to 8th January, 1945, and" and " in the case of a learner whose period of learnership commenced on or after 8th January, 1945," were deleted.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order, which has effect on and from 5th August, 1959, amends the Boot and Shoe Repairing Wages Council (Northern Ireland) Wages Regulation Order, 1951 (Order N.I.B.S. (67)), as amended by the Boot and Shoe Repairing Wages Council (Northern Ireland) Wages Regulation (Amendment) Order, 1958, (Order N.I.B.S. (79)) by increasing the statutory minimum remuneration fixed by those Orders.

Order N.I.B.S. (79) is revoked.

Blackface (Mourne) Rams Scheme, 1959

Scheme, dated 24th July, 1959, made by the Ministry of Agriculture under Section 9 of the Agriculture Act (Northern Ireland), 1949.

The Ministry of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 9 of the Agriculture Act (Northern Ireland), 1949(a), and of every power enabling it in that behalf, and with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following Scheme to modify the Blackface Rams Scheme, 1954(b) (hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Scheme"):

Citation and Commencement

- 1.—(1) This Scheme may be cited as the Blackface (Mourne) Rams Scheme. 1959.
- (2) This Scheme shall be read as one with the Principal Scheme and the Principal Scheme and this Scheme may be cited together as the Blackface Rams Scheme, 1954 and 1959.
- (3) This Scheme shall come into operation on the 31st day of August, 1959.

Revocation

2. The Blackface (Mourne) Rams Scheme, 1957(c), is hereby revoked from and after the commencement of this Scheme.
