EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to convey their general purport.)

The purpose of these Regulations is to increase the salaries and allowances payable to teachers in secondary intermediate schools by five per cent.

Grammar School Teachers: Salaries and Allowances

REGULATIONS DATED 30TH JANUARY, 1959, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION UNDER THE EDUCATION ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1947 TO 1958, AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE.

The Ministry of Education in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Sections 83 and 112 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland), 1947(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and after consultation with the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Grammar School (Salaries and Allowances of Teachers) Amending Regulations, 1959.
2. These Regulations shall take effect as from 1st February, 1959.
3. The existing Regulations hereby amended are the Grammar School (Salaries and Allowances of Teachers) Regulations, 1957(b).
4. The amount of the salary and of any allowances payable to a teacher under the provisions of the existing Regulations shall be increased by an addition calculated at the rate of five per cent.
