EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order does not introduce any change in the present importation requirements, but is necessary on the coming into force of the Diseases of Animals Act, 1958, so that cattle, goats, sheep, all ruminating animals and swine can enter Northern Ireland under the same conditions as heretofore.

MARKETING OF MILK PRODUCTS

REGULATIONS DATED THE 1ST DAY OF JANUARY, 1959, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION FIFTEEN OF THE MARKETING OF MILK PRODUCTS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1958.

The Ministry of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section Fifteen of the Marketing of Milk Products Act (Northern Ireland), 1958(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Short Title and Commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Marketing of Milk Products Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1959, and shall come into operation on the first day of January, 1959.

Forms

2. The forms set forth in the First Schedule hereto, or forms to the like effect, shall be used in the cases to which they are respectively expressed to be applicable, and shall for the purposes of the Act and of these Regulations be deemed to be the prescribed forms.

Application for Licences

3.—(1) Every application for a licence under Section One of the Act shall be made to the Ministry in the prescribed form.

(2) The fee for the issue or renewal of a licence shall be £10.

Registration of Premises

4. An application for the registration of premises under Section Two of the Act shall be made to the Ministry in the prescribed form.
