EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These amendments of the Training of Teachers (Courses) Regulations of 1957 enable the Ministry to give financial assistance to temporary teachers and part-time teachers who are selected for admission to approved courses. Provision is now made so that a teacher admitted to an approved course leading to the Bachelor of Education Degree will no longer be required to serve as a recognised teacher for 5 years before qualifying for a grant calculated by reference to his rate of salary.

FOYLE AREA (PRODUCTION OF LICENCE) REGULATIONS, 1959

The Foyle Fisheries Commission hereinafter referred to as "the Commission" in exercise of its powers under Section 13 of the Foyle Fisheries Act, 1952 and Section 13 of the Foyle Fisheries Act (Northern Ireland), 1952 hereby makes the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Foyle Area (Production of Licence) Regulations, 1959.

2. In these regulations:—

the expressions “authorised person” and “Foyle Area” have the respective meanings given to them in the Foyle Fisheries Act, 1952 and the Foyle Fisheries Act (Northern Ireland), 1952;

“licence” means a licence issued by the Commission authorising the holder to use a rod and line for fishing for salmon in the Foyle Area.

3. A person using in any part of the Foyle Area a rod and line for which a licence is required, or who is found with such a rod and line in his possession or control within 200 yards of any salmon fishing waters, or who is going to or returning from fishing for salmon, shall on demand by any authorised person produce a licence in his name valid at the time of such demand.

4. A person who on demand for a licence as provided herein does not produce such a licence for any reason whatsoever, or who fails to permit the authorised person making the demand to read such licence, shall be deemed to fail to produce a licence.

5. Nothing in these regulations shall be in derogation of any requirement of the Foyle Area (Licensing of Fishing Engines) (No. 2) Regulations, 1955.
