Contributions by Local Authorities

REGULATIONS, DATED 20TH MARCH, 1959, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SUB-SECTION (1) OF SECTION 126 AND SUB-SECTION (2) OF SECTION 134 OF THE CHILDREN AND YOUNG PERSONS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1950.

The Ministry of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by sub-section (1) of Section 126 and sub-section (2) of Section 134 of the Children and Young Persons Act (Northern Ireland), 1950(a), hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Citation and Commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Training Schools (Contributions by Local Authorities) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1959, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of April, 1959.

Contributions

2. The contributions to be made under sub-section (1) of Section 126 of the Children and Young Persons Act (Northern Ireland), 1950, by the local authority named in a training school order to the expenses of the managers of a training school throughout any time in the financial year 1959-60 during which the person to whom the order relates is under the care of the said managers and not out on licence or under supervision shall be at the rate of forty-three shillings and ninepence a week for Shamrock Lodge Training School and at the rate of ninety-three shillings a week for all other training schools.
