

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

The School Health Service Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1948, provided that health authorities should arrange for the dental inspection of school-children within twelve months after their admission to school and within the twelve months before their reaching school-leaving age and at other intervals as directed by the Ministry or determined by the health authority with the Ministry's approval.

The foregoing regulations modify these requirements and provide instead that there should be dental inspection of pupils within two years of their entering school and at such intervals thereafter as are directed by the Ministry or determined by the health authority with the Ministry's approval.

HOUSING

Small Dwellings Acquisition—Rate of Interest

ORDER, DATED 10TH APRIL, 1959, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE, UNDER SECTION FIVE OF THE HOUSING ACT, 1921.

The Ministry of Health and Local Government in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Section five of the Housing Act, 1921, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, hereby orders as follows:

1. The rate of interest on advances to be made under Section one of the Small Dwellings Acquisition Act, 1899, on or after the tenth day of April, 1959, shall be six per centum per annum:

Provided that nothing in this Order shall affect the rate of interest on any advance made or to be made or expenses incurred or to be incurred in respect of contracts entered into or applications granted under the said Section prior to the tenth of April, 1959, except that in cases where the local authority borrow at a rate of interest not exceeding five and three-quarters per centum per annum in order to make such advance, the rate of interest shall be six per centum per annum.

2. The Rate of Interest (Housing) (No. 3) Order (Northern Ireland), 1958(a), made by the Ministry of Health and Local Government on the twenty-fourth day of October, 1958, is hereby revoked.

3. This Order may be cited as the Rate of Interest (Housing) Order (Northern Ireland), 1959.
