POISONS

ORDER, DATED 12TH MAY, 1959, MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SUB-SECTION (6) OF SECTION TWENTY-SIX A OF THE MEDICINES, PHARMACY AND POISONS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1945.

Whereas the Poisons Board, constituted in accordance with section twenty-six of the Medicines, Pharmacy and Poisons Act (Northern Ireland), 1945(a), has recommended to me that the list of the substances which are to be treated as poisons for the purposes of the Pharmacy and Poisons Acts (Northern Ireland), 1925 to 1955, and known as "the Poisons Schedule" for the purposes of those Acts, should be amended so that certain additional substances should be included in Part I of the said schedule (which Part consists of those poisons which, subject to the provisions of the said Act, are not to be sold except by a person who is an authorised seller of poisons) and so that certain additional substances should be included in Part II of the said schedule (which Part consists of those poisons which, subject to the provisions of the said Act, are not to be sold except by a person who is an authorised seller of poisons or who is authorised by the local authority):

Now, therefore, I, the Right Honourable W. W. B. Topping, Q.C., M.P., Minister of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by sub-section (6) of section twenty-six A of the Medicines, Pharmacy and Poisons Act (Northern Ireland), 1945, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf do hereby order as follows:—

1. The Poisons List Confirmation Order (Northern Ireland), 1956(b), (which constitutes "the Poisons Schedule" for the purposes of the Pharmacy and Poisons Acts (Northern Ireland), 1925 to 1955) shall be amended and varied as follows, that is to say:—

- (a) Part I shall be amended and varied in the manner specified in the Schedule,
- (b) In Part II after the item commencing with the word "Dinoseb" there shall be inserted the item "Endrin", and in the item commencing with the words "Phosphorus compounds, the following" after the word "mazidox" there shall be inserted the words "2-methoxycarbonyl-1-methylvinyl dimethyl phosphate".

2. This Order may be cited as the Poisons List (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland), 1959, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of July, 1959.

SCHEDULE

AMENDMENTS AND VARIATIONS IN PART I OF THE POISONS SCHEDULE

In Part I of the Poisons Schedule—

- (a) after the item "Amyl nitrite" there shall be inserted the item "Anileridine; its salts";
- (b) the item "Chlorpromazine; its salts" shall be omitted;
- (c) after the item "Dextromethorphan; its salts" there shall be inserted the item "Dextromoramide; its salts";
- (d) after the item "Erythrityl tetranitrate" there shall be inserted the item "Etoxidine; its salts";
- (e) after the item "Levomethorphan its salts" there shall be inserted the item "Levomoramide; its salts";
- (f) after the item "Methyldesomorphine; its salts" there shall be inserted the item "Methyldihydromorphine; its salts";
- (g) for the item "1-Methyl-4-phenylpiperidine-4-carboxylic acid isopropyl ester; its salts" there shall be substituted the item "1-Methyl-4-phenylpiperidine-4-carboxylic acid, esters of; their salts";
- (h) after the item "Monofluoroacetic acid; its salts" there shall be inserted the item "Morpheridine; its salts";
- (i) after the item "Mustine; its salts" there shall be inserted the item "Myrophine; its salts";
- (j) after the item commencing with the words "Oxycinchoninic acid" there shall be inserted the item "Oxymorphone; its salts";
- (k) the item "Pethidine; its salts" shall be omitted;
- (l) after the item "Phenomorphane; its salts" there shall be inserted the item "3-(10-Phenothiazinyl)propane substituted in the 1-position; its salts; derivatives of 3-(10-Phenothiazinyl)propane substituted in the 1-position; their salts";
- (m) the item "promazine; its salts" shall be omitted;
- (n) after the item "Racemethorphan; its salts" there shall be inserted the item "Racemoramide; its salts"; and
- (o) after the item "Triethanmelamine; its salts" there shall be inserted the item "Trimeperidine; its salts".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order adds certain substances to the Poisons Schedule. Certain of the items added comprise substances already in the Schedule and the separate entries relating to these substances are therefore now omitted.
