Meat Examination Fees

ORDER, DATED 28TH MAY, 1959, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION 6 OF THE AGRICULTURAL PRODUCE (MEAT REGULATION) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1930, AS AMENDED BY SECTION 22 OF THE FINANCE (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1955.

Whereas it is provided by Section 6 of the Agricultural Produce (Meat Regulation) Act (Northern Ireland), 1930, as amended by Section 22 of the Finance (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act (Northern Ireland), 1955, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") that a person who holds a licence under the Act shall, for the examination of meat thereunder pay to the Ministry of Agriculture (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") at such times as may be specified in an order made under this section by the Ministry, with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, such fees in respect of each carcase (including offals) examined as may be so specified:

Now, therefore, the Ministry in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by the said Section of the Act, and of every other power enabling it in that behalf and with the approval of the Ministry of Finance hereby makes the following Order:—

1. (a) The fees to be paid by a person who holds a licence under the Act for the examination of meat thereunder as set out in Section 6 of the Act shall be varied so that the rates of such fees to be paid to the Ministry for each carcase (including offals) examined shall be as follows—

Beef	Three shillings and ninepence
Pork	One shilling
Mutton or Lamb	Sixpence
Goat	Sixpence
Horse	Three shillings and ninepence

- (b) Such fees shall be payable on demand to the Ministry.

2. The Meat Examination Fees Order (Northern Ireland), 1956, is revoked from the date on which this Order comes into operation.

3. This Order may be cited as the Meat Examination Fees Order (Northern Ireland), 1959, and shall come into operation on the fifteenth day of June, 1959.
