PUBLIC SERVICE VEHICLES

REGULATIONS, DATED 11TH JANUARY, 1960, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTIONS 12 AND 19 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES (TRAFFIC AND REGULATION) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1926.

The Ministry of Home Affairs in exercise of the powers vested in it by Sections 12 and 19 of the Motor Vehicles (Traffic and Regulation) Act (Northern Ireland), 1926(a), and of all other powers enabling it hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and Commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Service Vehicles (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1960, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of February, 1960.

Revocation or Suspension of Licence

2. For Regulation 25 of the Public Service Vehicles Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1951(b), there shall be substituted the following Regulation:—

“25. A licence granted to the driver or conductor of a public service vehicle shall be liable to revocation or suspension for any period of time by the Ministry in any of the following events:—

- (a) If the licence has been obtained by any misrepresentation;
- (b) If the licensee fails to comply with any of the conditions upon which the licence has been granted;
- (c) If the licensee has been convicted of an offence under the Acts or any Regulations made thereunder;
- (d) If in the opinion of the Ministry the licensee is unable to exercise his calling without risk to the public;
- (e) If the conduct of the licensee is or has been during the currency of the licence such as to render it inadvisable, in the opinion of the Ministry, that he should continue to hold the licence.

In the event of such revocation or suspension the Ministry shall give or cause to be given to the licensee notice in writing of such revocation or suspension. Such notice may be served either personally or by post and the licence shall be deemed to be revoked or suspended as from the date of such service.”
