DISEASES OF ANIMALS**Scheduled Diseases (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland), 1960**

ORDER, DATED 5TH JULY, 1960, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER THE DISEASES OF ANIMALS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1958(a).

The Ministry of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sub-section (2) of section one of the Diseases of Animals Act (Northern Ireland), 1958, and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order which may be cited as the Scheduled Diseases (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland), 1960, shall come into operation on the 1st day of August, 1960.

Amendment of the First Schedule of the Act

2. Part III of the First Schedule of the Act shall be amended by adding at the end thereof—

“16. Brucellosis”.

Restriction of Application of Act

3.—(1) Sub-section (1) of section four of the Act shall not apply to the diseases specified in this Article.

(2) The provisions of the Act (other than sub-section (1) of section four) shall apply to the diseases specified in this Article to such extent only as may be necessary for the purpose of giving effect to any order of the Ministry relating to the said diseases.

(3) The diseases to which this Article applies are—

- (a) Brucellosis
- (b) Epizootic abortion
- (c) Warble fly infestation.
