MARKETING OF EGGS

RULES, DATED THIRD DAY OF FEBRUARY, 1960, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION 21 OF THE MARKETING OF EGGS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1957.

The Ministry of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 21 of the Marketing of Eggs Act (Northern Ireland), 1957(a), and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Rules:—

Citation and Commencement

1. These Rules may be cited as the Marketing of Eggs (Amendment) Rules (Northern Ireland), 1960, and shall come into operation on the 29th day of February, 1960.

Definition

2. "The Principal Rules" means the Marketing of Eggs Rules (Northern Ireland), 1958(b).

Amendments to Principal Rules

3. For the provisions of the Principal Rules referred to in the first column of the Schedule hereto there shall be substituted respectively the provisions set out in the second column of that Schedule.

Rule 24, Paragraph (1)	He shall use only delivery cases No. 1, No. 2 or No. 3 constructed of the materials and in accordance with the specifications prescribed in the Third Schedule and sealed top and bottom in such manner as may be approved by the Ministry from time to time, and either fillers and flats or egg trays manufactured to the specification contained in the Third Schedule; provided that the Ministry may approve the use of special types of cases and packing material to meet special market needs.
Rule 25, Paragraph (1)	All cases shall be marked in a manner approved by the Ministry on each end of the case with letters not less than half an inch in height indicating:— (a) the licence-holder's registered number; (b) the grade, designation or class as appropriate; and (c) the date of testing which shall be indicated by means of such code as is directed by the Board.
Rule 38, Paragraph (1)	Eggs cold stored or chemically stored shall, prior to such storage, have been marked in a legible and indelible manner, on the shell, in the former case with the word "Chilled" or the words "Cold Stored", and in the latter case with the word "Sterilised", the letters being in each case not less than one-eighth of an inch in height, the words being enclosed in a circle of not less than three-quarters of an inch in diameter. Provided that where the cold stored eggs are to be broken out the obligation to mark the eggs with the aforesaid designations may be waived, if the prior consent of the Ministry is obtained and subject to such conditions as the Ministry may impose.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Rules but is intended to indicate the general purport.)

These Rules make some minor amendments to the Marketing of Eggs Rules (Northern Ireland), 1958, and in particular will permit the use of pre-pack (No. 3) egg trays and cases and the stamping of code dates directly on to the boxes.
