Institutions of Further Education: Salaries and Allowances

REGULATIONS, DATED 29TH JULY, 1960, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION UNDER THE EDUCATION ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1947 TO 1958, AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE.

The Ministry of Education in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Sections 83 and 112 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland), 1947(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf and after consultation with the Ministry of Finance hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Institutions of Further Education (Salaries and Allowances) Amending Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1960.

(2) These Regulations shall take effect on 1st August, 1960.

2. The Regulations hereby amended are the Institutions of Further Education (Salaries and Allowances) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1959(b).

3. For paragraph (2) of Regulation 11 of the existing Regulations there shall be substituted the following paragraph:—

“(2) A Principal of an institution, or a Head of Department, Principal Lecturer or Senior Lecturer in the College of Technology, Belfast, shall be given incremental credit on the appropriate salary scale in accordance with the provisions of Schedule VI:

Provided that a person appointed to one of these posts who is not entitled to receive incremental credit on the salary scale appropriate to the post under Schedule VI shall, on transfer to that scale from another scale under these Regulations, be placed at a point on that scale equal to his accrued salary on his former scale together with an increment on his new scale, if that point is higher than the minimum of his new scale.”

4. After Schedule V of the existing Regulations there shall be added the following Schedule:—

“SCHEDULE VI

Regulation 11

Credit for the following full-time service and experience shall be given in the appropriate salary scale:

<i>Salary Scale</i>	<i>Type of service or experience</i>
Principal, Head of Department, Principal Lecturer, Senior Lecturer.	Teaching service adjudged by the Ministry to have been equivalent in importance and responsibility to the post in respect of which the teacher is being placed.
