NURSES AND MIDWIVES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1959

Date of Commencement

Order, dated 1st February, 1960, made by the Minister of Health and Local Government under Section 60 of the Nurses and Midwives Act (Northern Ireland), 1959.

- I, The Right Honourable J. L. O. Andrews, Minister of Health and Local Government, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 60 of the Nurses and Midwives Act (Northern Ireland), 1959(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf do hereby order as follows:—
- 1. This Order may be cited as the Nurses and Midwives Act (Northern Ireland), 1959, (Date of Commencement) Order (Northern Ireland), 1960.
- 2. The provisions of Section 1, sub-section (1) of Section 8, Section 57 and sub-section (1) of Section 58 of the Act shall come into operation on the date of this Order.
- 3. The remaining provisions of the Act and of the Schedules to the Act shall come into operation on the 1st day of July, 1960.
