AGRICULTURE**Poultry Breeding**

SCHEME, DATED 28TH APRIL, 1961, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION NINE OF THE AGRICULTURE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1949(a).

The Ministry of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sub-section (1) of Section nine of the Agriculture Act (Northern Ireland), 1949, and of every other power enabling it in that behalf and with the approval of the Ministry of Finance hereby makes the following Scheme:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Scheme may be cited as the Poultry Breeding (Amendment No. 2) Scheme (Northern Ireland), 1961, and shall come into operation on the 29th day of April, 1961.

Amendments to Scheme

2. The Poultry Breeding Scheme (Northern Ireland), 1958(b), as amended by the Poultry Breeding (Amendment) Scheme (Northern Ireland), 1960(c), shall be further amended as follows:—

(1) In sub-paragraph (a) of Paragraph (1) of Article 7 the words “until the birds are 475 days old” shall be substituted for the words “until the birds are 500 days old”.

(2) In sub-paragraph (b) of Paragraph (1) of Article 11 the words “until they are 475 days old” shall be substituted for the words “until they are 500 days old”.
