BUT EXCLUDING

the making of wire rope (unless made in the same factory or workshop as hemp or similar rope or core for wire rope),

AND EXCLUDING

the making of net in connection with the lace curtain trade and the weaving of cloth;

AND EXCLUDING ALSO

the splicing or braiding of rope, twine or cord performed by hand or machine when incidental to or carried on in association with or in conjunction with the operations specified in paragraphs (1) and (2) of the Appendix to the Trade Boards (Made-up Textiles) Order, 1920(a), or any other processes or operations which are specifically mentioned in such Appendix.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order, which comes into operation on 4th September, 1961, sets out the statutory minimum remuneration payable in substitution for that fixed by the Rope, Twine and Net Wages Council (Northern Ireland) Wages Regulation Order, 1954 (Order N.I.R. (64)), as amended by the Rope, Twine and Net Wages Regulation (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland), 1960 (Order N.I.R. (76)), which Orders are revoked.

Marketing of Potatoes

REGULATIONS, DATED 5TH SEPTEMBER, 1961, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE, UNDER SECTION THREE OF THE MARKETING OF POTATOES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1928(b), AS AMENDED BY SECTION THREE OF THE AGRICULTURE (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1960(c).

In exercise of the powers conferred on it by section three of the Marketing of Potatoes Act (Northern Ireland), 1928, as amended by section three of the Agriculture (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act (Northern Ireland), 1960, and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, the Ministry of Agriculture with the approval of the Ministry of Finance hereby makes the following regulations:

Short Title and Commencement

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Marketing of Potatoes Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1961.
