LOCAL AUTHORITIES**Qualifications of Architects**

REGULATIONS, DATED 3RD OCTOBER, 1961, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNDER SECTION 18 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1934.

The Ministry of Health and Local Government (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") in exercise of the powers vested in it by section 18 of the Local Government Act (Northern Ireland), 1934(a), and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations, that is to say:—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Local Authorities (Architects Qualifications) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1961.

(2) In these Regulations the expression "registered architect" means a person registered under the Architects (Registration) Acts, 1931 to 1938(b), and the expression "local authority" means the council of a county, county or other borough, or urban or rural district or any committee of, or joint committee or joint board partly appointed by, such council.

2. A person shall not be qualified to be appointed to the office of Architect or Assistant Architect of a local authority unless—

- (a) he is a registered architect;
- (b) he has had adequate and suitable experience; and
- (c) he is a British subject.

3. The Local Authorities (Architects Qualifications) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1946(c), are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)
