### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)*

These Regulations replace with amendments the Health Services (Payment of Fees) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1950, and the Health Services (Payment of Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1950. They empower the Northern Ireland Hospitals Authority to pay fees not exceeding the sum of two hundred and fifty guineas in any period of twelve months to the Chairman of the Distinction Awards Sub-Committee, and to pay a fee not exceeding seven guineas per day to retired members of the Distinction Awards Sub-Committee in respect of attendances at meetings of that Sub-Committee.

### HOUSING

#### Small Dwellings Acquisition—Rate of Interest

ORDER, DATED 13TH OCTOBER, 1961, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE, UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE HOUSING ACT, 1921.

The Ministry of Health and Local Government in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Section 5 of the Housing Act, 1921(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, hereby orders as follows:

1. This Order may be cited as the Rate of Interest (Housing) (No. 3) Order (Northern Ireland), 1961.

2. The rate of interest on advances to be made under Section 1 of the Small Dwellings Acquisition Act, 1899(b), on or after the 14th day of October, 1961, shall be
