COUNTY COURTS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1959

County Courts—County of Down

Order, dated 27th October, 1961, made by the Minister of Home Affairs under sections two and four of the County Courts Act (Northern Ireland), 1959.

I, the Right Honourable Brian Faulkner, Minister of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by sections two and four of the County Courts Act (Northern Ireland), 1959(a), do hereby order as follows:—

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the County Courts Times of Sittings (County Down) Order (Northern Ireland), 1961.

Times of sittings and nature of business to be transacted

2. The ordinary sittings of the county courts for the divisions and the places in those divisions set out in the first column of the First Schedule shall be held within the periods shown in the second column of that Schedule and the nature of the business to be transacted by such courts shall be as specified in the third column of that Schedule.

Revocations

3. The Orders specified in the Second Schedule are hereby revoked to the extent specified in the second column of that Schedule.
