### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)*

These Regulations prescribe that an application for Capital Grant must be submitted within the accounting period to which it relates, instead of before the end of 3 months after the accounting period, as formerly; but the Ministry is given discretion, which it did not previously have, to accept a late application in exceptional circumstances.

### DISEASES OF ANIMALS

#### Eradication of Bovine Tuberculosis

ORDER, DATED 22ND DECEMBER, 1961, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION 3 OF THE DISEASES OF ANIMALS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1958(a).

The Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland by virtue of and in exercise of the powers vested in it under Section 3 of the Diseases of Animals Act (Northern Ireland), 1958, and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

#### *Citation and commencement*

1. This Order, which may be cited as the Tuberculosis (Area Eradication) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland), 1961, shall come into operation on the 15th day of January, 1962.

#### *Amendment of Principal Order*

2. The Tuberculosis (Area Eradication) Order (Northern Ireland), 1959(b), shall be amended as follows:

(1) In Article 4 of the said Order, after paragraph 2 there shall be added the following paragraph:—
