Eradication of Bovine Tuberculosis

Order, dated 22nd December, 1961, made by the Ministry of Agriculture under Section 3 of the Diseases of Animals Act (Northern Ireland), 1958(a).

The Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland by virtue of and in exercise of the powers vested in it under Section 3 of the Diseases of Animals Act (Northern Ireland), 1958, and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order, which may be cited as the Tuberculosis (Area Eradication) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland), 1961, shall come into operation on the 15th day of January, 1962.

Amendment of Principal Order

- 2. The Tuberculosis (Area Eradication) Order (Northern Ireland), 1959(b), shall be amended as follows:
