

- (3) Dublin Road, Trunk Road No. T.3, Omagh, Co. Tyrone, from a point approximately 350 yards south-east of the junction with Golf Links Lane to a point approximately 750 yards south-east of this junction.
- (4) The Strabane-Londonderry Road, Trunk Road No. T.3, Strabane, Co. Tyrone, from a point approximately 800 yards north of the northern junction with Canal Street, Strabane, to a point approximately 1,670 yards north of this junction.

NATIONAL INSURANCE

REGULATIONS, DATED 1ST DAY OF MARCH, 1961, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION, UNDER SECTION 11 OF THE NATIONAL INSURANCE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1959.

The Ministry of Education in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 11 of the National Insurance Act (Northern Ireland), 1959(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and after making the consultations required by sub-section (3) of that section, hereby makes the following regulations:

1. These regulations may be cited as the National Insurance (Non-participation—Teachers Superannuation) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1961, and shall come into operation on the 3rd day of April, 1961.

2. "The Act" means the National Insurance Act (Northern Ireland), 1959;

"The Acts of 1950 to 1956" means the Teachers (Superannuation) Acts (Northern Ireland), 1950 to 1956;

"The Ministry" means the Ministry of Education.

3. Employment in contributory service within the meaning of the Acts of 1950 to 1956, shall be treated as employment under a single employer different from the employer in any other employment for the purposes of—

(a) sub-section (4) of section 8 of the Act (which section relates to liability to make payments in lieu of contributions); and

(b) regulation 4 of the National Insurance (Non-participation—Assurance of Equivalent Pension Benefits) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1960(b), (which regulation relates to the giving of notice of the ending of employment which is non-participating within the meaning of the Act).

4.—(1) In relation to employment in contributory service within the meaning of the Acts of 1950 to 1956, things that are required or authorised to be done by or to the employer under the provisions specified in paragraph (2) of this regulation shall be done by or to the Ministry.

(2) The provisions referred to in the last foregoing paragraph are the National Insurance (Non-participation—Assurance of Equivalent Pension Benefits) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1960.
