NATIONAL INSURANCE AND INDUSTRIAL INJURIES**Commencement Order (Northern Ireland), 1961**

ORDER, DATED 22ND MARCH, 1961, MADE BY THE MINISTER OF LABOUR AND NATIONAL INSURANCE UNDER THE NATIONAL INSURANCE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1960.

Whereas it is provided by sub-section (3) of section 9 of the National Insurance Act (Northern Ireland), 1960(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1960"), that the provisions mentioned in that sub-section shall come into operation only on such day as the Minister of Labour and National Insurance may by order appoint:

Now, therefore, I, the Right Honourable Ivan Neill, Minister of Labour and National Insurance for Northern Ireland, hereby make the following Order:

1. The day of coming into operation of sections 5 and 6 of the Act of 1960 (which sections substitute a new section and a new paragraph relating to the Commissioner and deputy Commissioners appointed for the purposes of the National Insurance (Industrial Injuries) Act (Northern Ireland), 1946(b) and the National Insurance Act (Northern Ireland), 1946(c), for section 42 and paragraph (c) of sub-section (3) of section 40 of those Acts respectively) shall be the 3rd April, 1961.

2. This Order may be cited as the National Insurance and Industrial Injuries (Commencement) Order (Northern Ireland), 1961.
