EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

The Agriculture (Poisonous Substances) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1958, include regulations whereby workers may not carry out or be required by their employers to carry out certain operations in connection with the poisonous substances which are scheduled in the Regulations unless prescribed safety measures are observed.

These Regulations add two further organo-phosphorous compounds to the list of scheduled poisonous substances namely:—

Azinphos-ethyl

Oxydemeton-methyl

COMPULSORY ACQUISITION OF LAND

Interest on Compensation Money

ORDER, DATED 26TH JULY, 1962, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER SECTION 12 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1955, AND SECTION 14 OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE AND FINANCIAL PROVISIONS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1956.

The Ministry of Finance for Northern Ireland in pursuance of the powers conferred on it by Section 12 of the Public Health and Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act (Northern Ireland), 1955(a), and Section 14 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland), 1956(b), and of all other powers it thereunto enabling hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Compulsory Acquisition of Land (Interest on Compensation Money) Order (Northern Ireland), 1962.

2. The Compulsory Acquisition of Land (Interest on Compensation Money) Order (Northern Ireland), 1961(c), shall, as from the date of this Order, be revoked.
