Commencement No. 3 Order (Northern Ireland), 1962

ORDER, DATED 23RD OCTOBER, 1962, MADE BY THE MINISTER OF LABOUR AND NATIONAL INSURANCE UNDER THE FACTORIFS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1959.

Whereas it is provided by sub-section (2) of section 35 of the Factories Act (Northern Ireland), 1959(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), that the provisions of the Act other than sections 23 and 35 shall come into operation on such day or days as the Minister of Labour and National Insurance may by order appoint:

Now, therefore, I, the Right Honourable Herbert Victor Kirk, Minister of Labour and National Insurance for Northern Ireland, in pursuance of the said sub-section (2) of section 35 of the Act, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:-

1. The provisions of the Act specified in the Schedule to this Order shall come into operation on the first day of December, 1962.

2. This Order may be cited as the Factories (Commencement No. 3) Order (Northern Ireland), 1962.
