**FOYLE FISHERIES****Foyle Area (Close Season for Angling) Regulations, 1962**

REGULATIONS, DATED 19TH FEBRUARY, 1962, MADE BY THE FOYLE FISHERIES COMMISSION WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER FOR LANDS OF THE IRISH REPUBLIC UNDER SECTION 13 OF THE FOYLE FISHERIES ACT, 1952, AND OF THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER SECTION 13 OF THE FOYLE FISHERIES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1952.

The Foyle Fisheries Commission in exercise of its powers under Section 13 of the Foyle Fisheries Act, 1952, and Section 13 of the Foyle Fisheries Act (Northern Ireland), 1952, hereby makes the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Foyle Area (Close Season for Angling) Regulations, 1962, and shall come into force on the first day of October, 1962.

2. It is hereby prescribed that the annual close season for angling in the River Mourne its lakes and tributaries shall be from the first day in October in any year to the thirty-first day in March in the year following both days inclusive.

3. So much of any bye-law or regulation now in force as governs the annual close season for angling in the waters specified in Article 2 of these regulations is hereby revoked.

4. These regulations if not earlier revoked shall remain in force until the thirty-first day of March, 1967, and shall then cease to have effect.
